Course Description

This three-day **SuiteCommerce InStore: Fundamentals** course will provide you with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively set up, configure and manage a SuiteCommerce InStore (SCIS) site to support common retail point-of-sale use cases. As part of this course, you will complete several hands-on exercises that will provide you with real-world experience configuring the necessary back-end ERP processes, SCIS custom records and related SCIS site preferences to support typical in-store, pointof-sale use cases.

- Manage subsidiaries, locations and tax nexuses as they relate to the collection of taxes in each supported tax jurisdiction?
- Configure standard NetSuite records and SCIS custom records to support the foundational capabilities of SCIS?
- Configure the necessary accounts and effectively manage the assignment of employee cash drawer accounts at each location?

Provides an overview of the foundational terminologies, concepts, products and installation components associated with the

- Perform SCIS point-of-sale transactions, such as accepting various payment methods, applying discounts, markups and promotions, processing returns and exchanges, updating customer information, and running saved searches and sales reports?
- Support orders for delivery and store pickup and effectively manage the fulfillment of each type of order?
- Customize the SCIS receipt templates generated during sales transactions using NetSuite's Advanced PDF/HTML Templates feature?
- Approach the localization of an SCIS site for use in multiple geographic locales?

Installation and Initial Web Site Setup: Learn about the initial installation and configuration tasks required to successfully log in to SCIS, as well as the required peripheral devices supported by SCIS, such as barcode scanners, receipt printers, cash drawers and mobile POS devices. Learn how to create a Web Site Setup record and configure the necessary settings to host a SCIS site.

User Roles and Permissions: Examine the delivered user roles and permissions installed with the SCIS SuiteApp bundle and configure authorization overrides, which allow administrators to grant or restrict access to specific SCIS operations based on user role.

Setting Up Subsidiaries, Locations and Taxes:

Learn about the importance of locations and subsidiaries in a typical SCIS implementation, as well as the various tax settings that must be made to ensure the proper tax calculations for specific geographic locations.

SCIS Record Configuration: Learn about the configuration of both standard NetSuite records and SCIS custom records to support the various capabilities of SCIS.

Cash Drawer Management: Learn how NetSuite handles cash management and the assignment of cash drawers by default, and how to configure a more flexible approach that streamlines initial loan operations, sales transactions and end-of-day operations.

Day 3 Agenda

The SCIS User Experience: Learn about many of the point-of-sale capabilities of SCIS, such as adding customers and items to a sales transaction, processing payments, returns, refunds and exchanges, working with customer information, and viewing saved searches and sales reports.

Orders for Delivery/Store Pickup: Examine the transactional workflows associated with ship-from-store and store pickup and configure the necessary back-end NetSuite components to support each omnichannel commerce use case.
