Do you need to learn how to manage your organization's NetSuite WMS account? If so, this course will provide you with the foundational knowledge needed to setup, maintain and utilize your NetSuite solution.

WMS: Fundamentals examines the foundational knowledge needed to configure and utilize NetSuite for your organization by examining key tasks and responsibilities for the warehouse administrator, inventory manager and warehouse operator.

Inbound – Receiving and Putaway Items:

Receive different types of orders using the RF handheld scanner; receive orders; putaway items; post item receipts; print item labels.

Outbound – Fulfillment: Examine the outbound process of item fulfillment; pick orders; pack orders; ship orders.

Internal – Manage Inventory: Create and manage warehouse inventory; search inventory; transfer inventory items; replenish bins; create inventory; perform a cycle count.

Work Orders: Process work orders; pick component items; build assembly items.
