

The TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) is a standardized test that measures the English language proficiency of non-native English speakers. The test is divided into four sections:

1. Reading - This section measures your ability to read and understand academic texts in English.
2. Listening - This section measures your ability to understand spoken English as it is used in universities and colleges.
3. Speaking - This section measures your ability to speak English clearly and effectively in an academic setting.
4. Writing - This section measures your ability to write in English, including grammar, vocabulary, and organization.
