The out-of-the-box (OOTB) Data Aggregator (DA) in CA Performance Management supports common vendor devices using certifications. Certifications specify how to collect configuration and performance metrics for a device. However, you might need to collect data when the DA does not provide an OOTB certification for your network devices, or you may wish to collect data for an entirely new set of metrics. Through hands-on lab exercises, you will use self-certification to create the custom objects needed to meet monitoring requirements not met by the OOTB certifications and metrics.
