 Microsoft 365 applications to streamline workflows and enhance productivity.
- Crafting Effective Prompts for Copilot Learn how to craft precise, effective prompts to
 maximize Copilot's potential. Well-structured prompts are essential for generating highquality, actionable results that support decision-making and task automation. After
 refining your prompt skills, experience a demonstration of a functional group business
 scenario, highlighting how Copilot applies to real-world tasks. Each session highlights
 different Microsoft 365 applications depending on the business function being explored.

Copilot Immersion Experience – Apply what you've learned in an interactive experience tailored to a specific business function. Participants will engage in tasks relevant to their roles, exploring how Copilot can drive efficiencies, enhance decision-making, and optimize workflows. Each session aligns with a functional area, ensuring participants gain practical insights into how Copilot can be integrated into their daily work.

Audience prerequisites

- Access to a Microsoft 365 subscription (BYOS) in which they're licensed to use Microsoft 365 Copilot.
- A laptop or tablet with Microsoft 365 apps installed and ready to use.
- A Microsoft OneDrive account, since Microsoft 365 Copilot requires OneDrive to complete the file sharing tasks used throughout the immersion experience.
