

# Getting started with Power BI and Copilot in M365

Duration – 4 hours

## Overview

This introductory course provides a practical overview of Power BI and Copilot in Microsoft 365 for beginners. Participants will learn how to connect to data, create basic reports, and understand key data visualization concepts using Power BI. The course also introduces Copilot capabilities across Microsoft 365 applications, demonstrating how AI can support data analysis, content creation, and everyday productivity tasks. Through guided demonstrations and real-world examples, attendees will gain a clear understanding of how these tools work together to support informed decision-making and more efficient ways of working.

## Audience Profile

This course is intended for professionals who are new to Power BI and Copilot in Microsoft 365 and want to build a foundational understanding of data analytics and AI-enabled productivity tools. It is suitable for business users, analysts, managers, and knowledge workers across functions who regularly work with data, reports, or Microsoft 365 applications. Prior experience with Power BI or Copilot is not required; however, basic familiarity with Excel or other Microsoft tools will be beneficial. The course is designed for learners seeking practical, easy-to-understand guidance rather than deep technical or development-focused training.
